Proposed parking changes for CS1 permit parking area

Following our informal consultation in October 2022, where residents on Strawberry Lane and Nightingale Road expressed an interest in extending the CS1 permit parking area (PPA), we are now moving to a final consultation about proposed parking changes to the PPA.

Proposals for the CS1 PPA

The CS1 PPA operates Monday to Friday from 11am to 1pm. We are proposing to

- extend the boundary of the CS1 PPA to include Strawberry Lane, Nightingale Road and a short length of Culvers Way
- to extend permit eligibility to the following residential properties
 - Nightingale Road Even Nos. 36-50, Odd Nos 21-47 (including 45a & 47a)
 - Culvers Way No. 128
 - Strawberry Lane Even Nos 14-60 and Odd Nos. 1-61
- change freebay parking on the footway to permit bay parking on footway at locations on Nightingale Road and Culvers Way
- Introduce double yellow lines on Nightingale Road to protect footway parking bays and to maintain traffic flow.
