## Proposed parking changes for Mill Lane and Denmark Road

Following our informal consultation in October 2022 we are now moving to a final consultation about proposed parking changes to your street.

## **Proposals for Mill Lane and Denmark Road**

- To assist with obstructive parking we are proposing double yellow lines (with no loading at any time) outside Nos 101 and 103 Denmark Road.
- To aid customer parking at local businesses we are proposing a time limited bay on Mill Lane (opposite Millpond Place) operating Monday to Friday 11am-1pm (maximum stay 30 minutes, no return within 2 hours). See Map on the back of this letter for more detail.
