# Proposed parking changes for Leslie Gardens

Following our informal consultation in May 2023 we are now moving to a final consultation about proposed parking changes for your street.

### **Proposal for Leslie Gardens**

Following requests from local residents we are proposing double yellow lines on the corner of the road (outside No 9 and 21 Leslie Gardens) and an extension of the double yellow lines (adjacent to No 58 Worcester Road) to ease access issues (see detailed map on the back of this letter).
