## Proposed parking changes for Waverley Avenue/Montrose Gardens

Following our informal consultation in June 2023 we are now moving to a final consultation about proposed parking changes for your street.

## Proposal for Waverley Avenue/Montrose Gardens

Following requests from London Fire Brigade we are proposing to add double yellow lines from No 32 Waverley Ave to Angel Hill, due to access issues. Following feedback to our informal consultation we are also proposing extending double yellow lines on the corner of Montrose Gardens due to access issues (see detailed map on the back of this letter).


