Proposed parking changes for Carters Close, Handside Close and Southwood Close

We're writing to you as part of our ongoing review of parking in Sutton.

Parking remains one of the issues of most concern to residents in Sutton and we have received many requests for a review of parking arrangements across the borough.

Proposals for Carters Close, Handside Close and Southwood Close

Following local requests we are proposing to add double yellow lines at multiple locations due to obstructive parking blocking access, including for bin collections (see detailed map on the back of this letter).
