Proposed parking changes for Sparrow Farm Road/Bradstock Road

We're writing to you as part of our ongoing review of parking in Sutton.

Parking remains one of the issues of most concern to residents in Sutton and we have received many requests for a review of parking arrangements across the borough.

Proposal for Sparrow Farm Road/Bradstock Road

Following local requests we are proposing to extend double yellow lines outside Nos 71-73 Sparrow Farm Road (near the junction with Bradstock Road) due to obstructive parking causing access and safety issues.

We are also proposing to extend the double yellow lines on Sparrow Farm Road near the junction with Woodstone Ave (to the dropped kerb outside No 74 Sparrow Farm Road) due to obstructive parking causing safety issues.

This informal stage of consultation will end on **11 January 2024**. We will review the feedback and speak with ward councillors before a decision is made whether to progress any formal proposals for changes.
