Proposed parking changes for Elm Road West/Woodstock Avenue

Following our informal consultation in October 2023 we are now moving to a final consultation about proposed parking changes for your street.

Proposal for Elm Road West/Woodstock Avenue

Following feedback we have revised our previous proposals. We are now proposing to extend double yellow lines at the junction (adjacent to No 41 Woodstock Avenue only). The proposals follow local requests to improve visibility at the junction due to parked vehicles obstructing sight lines **(see detailed map on the back of this letter)**.

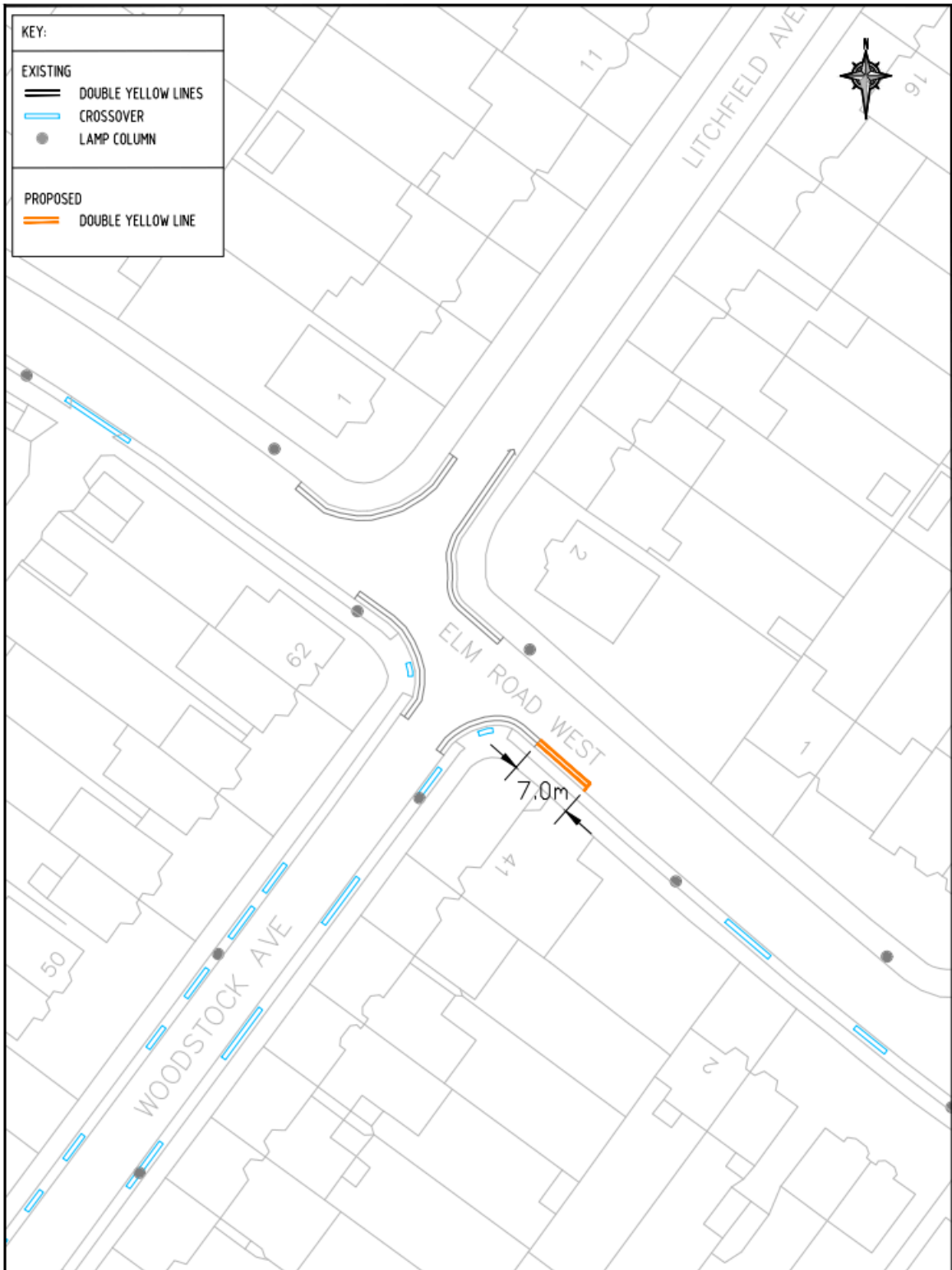
