COUNCIL TAX – CARERS


You could be entitled to a discount in your Council Tax if you:

Provide care for another member of your household for at least 35 hours a week.

And the person receiving care is in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Any rate of attendance allowance
- The highest or middle rates of the care component of a disability living allowance **or** the standard or enhanced rate of the daily living component of personal independence payment under section 78(3) of the Welfare Reform Act 2012.
- The highest determinable rate of a disablement pension
- An increase in a constant attendance allowance under a Military Service Pension Order

Please note that discounts may not be granted to parents providing care for their children (if under 18 years of age) or in cases where care is provided by one spouse for another and also where there are more than 2 adults resident in the property.
