

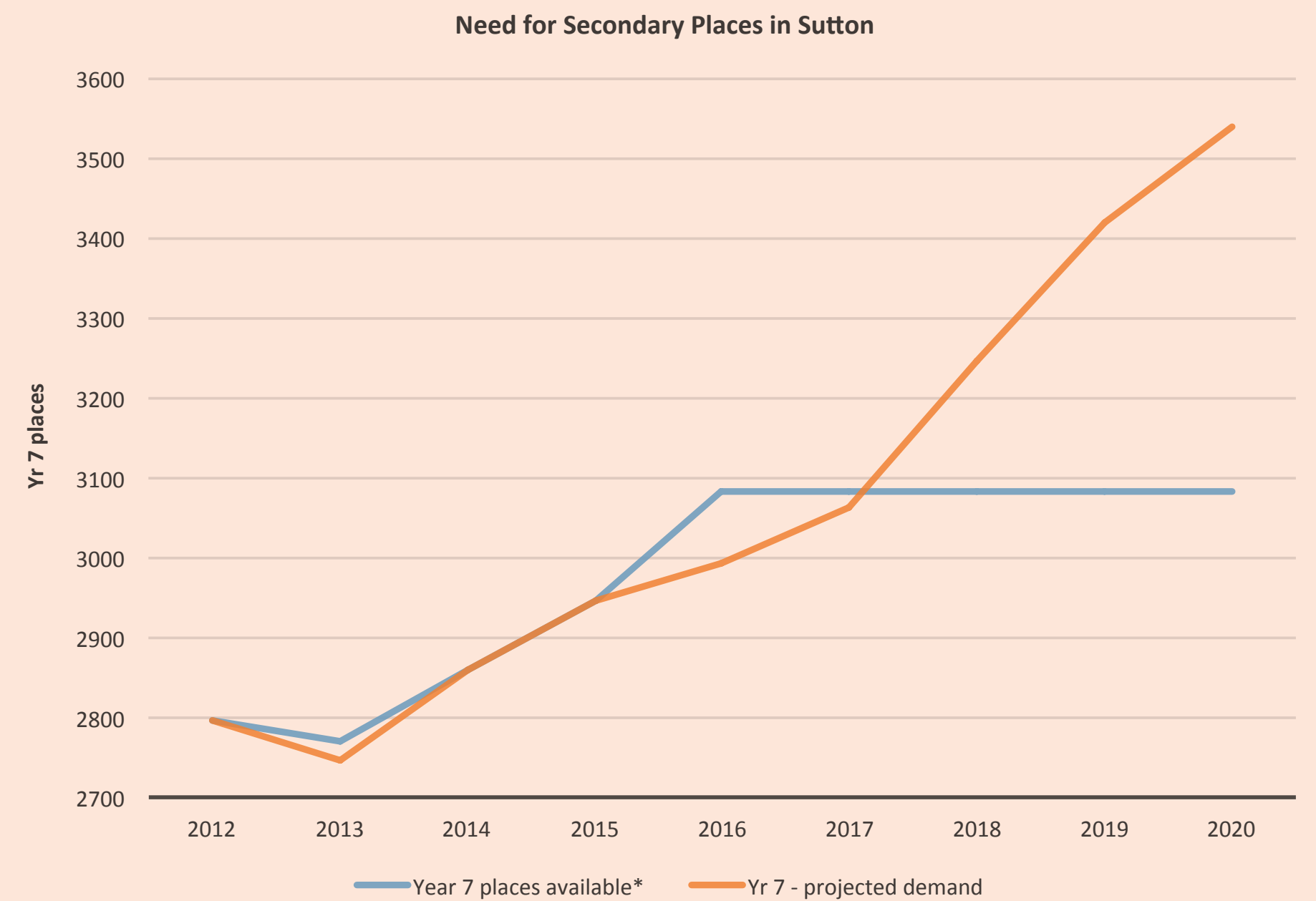
New Sutton Secondary School (NS³) *the Sutton Hospital site*

A growing school population....

- Births have increased in Sutton by 30% since 2001.
- LBS has commissioned over 4,200 additional primary school places since 2008.
- Additional primary provision is being planned in Hackbridge but further primary provision is expected to be needed in central Sutton over the local plan period.
- 10 of Sutton's secondary schools are in the process of expanding providing over 2,600 additional secondary school places but it will not be enough.
- A new secondary school is needed by 2018 with further school provision probably needed by 2019 or 2020.

A constrained Borough....

- Finding sites for new school provision is a challenge in a small London borough where land is scarce and very expensive.
- From a longlist of 280 sites the Council has named the Sutton Hospital site as the preferred site for the first new secondary school. Choices were very limited as it is the only brownfield site in the Council's ownership capable of supporting secondary education in the borough.
- Options for further site allocations for primary and secondary school provision are being explored through the Issues and Options consultation on the Local Plan.



A new secondary school for Sutton.... the vision

- New Sutton Secondary School (NS³) will provide outstanding education in an innovative and inclusive learning environment
- Science specialism – particularly Health and Life Sciences.
- Integral part of The London Cancer Hub with the Institute of Cancer Research and the Royal Marsden NHS Foundation Trust as main employer partners.
- Outstanding technical, vocational and academic suite of subjects delivered through a wide ranging curriculum.

About the School

- Fully comprehensive, no selection on admission, 11-19 secondary school and sixth form.
- Will be 6 forms of entry admitting between 180 and 195 pupils a year – 1275 in total (including 6th form).
- Operating an 'extended day', enrichment and extracurricular activities, after school and breakfast clubs, on site sports facilities....

Community Benefits

- Community resource for leisure and learning activities, including enhanced sports provision, music and drama space, as well as meeting rooms for community activities.
- More choice for parents and pupils - with its science specialism and links to The London Cancer Hub, NS³ provides a vibrant new option in the borough that many parents and children will find attractive.
- Employment - the building process will provide employment for local suppliers to the main contractor. The new school will provide a range of employment for teaching and non-teaching staff, as well as support staff.

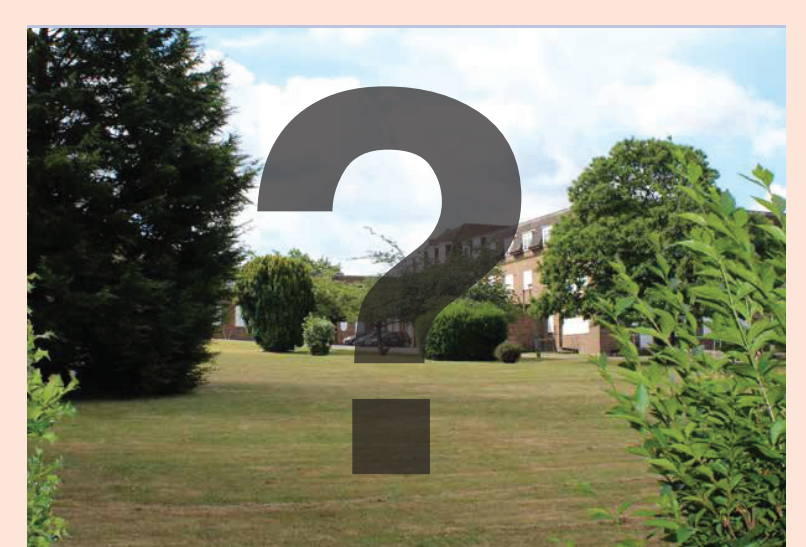

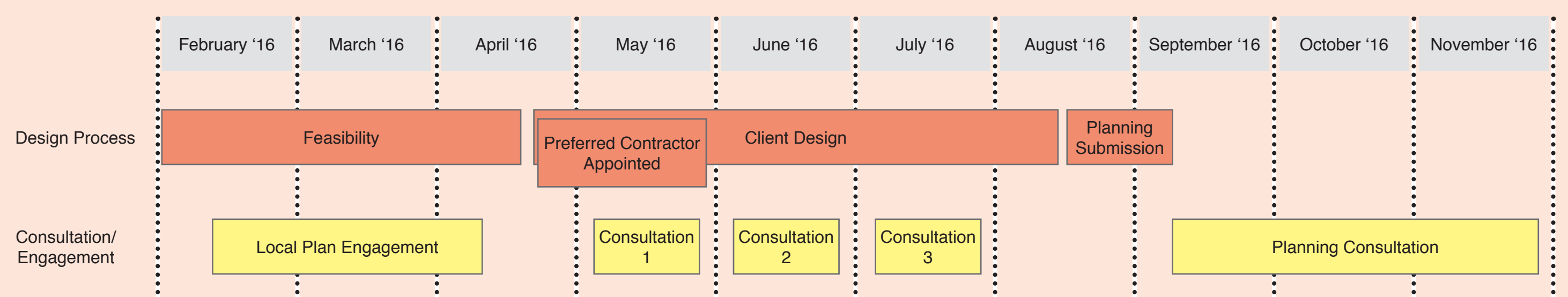
