## **About Us**

We provide free information, advice and guidance on childcare, early education, activities and services for children and young people aged 0-19 years (or 25 if the young person has an additional need) and their families in the London Borough of Sutton.

We hold the only childcare database in the borough which contains comprehensive information about Ofsted-registered childcare (the Family Service Directory). By searching the directory, you can locate registered childminders, day nurseries, preschools, breakfast clubs, after school clubs and holiday schemes in your area. You can also find local leisure activities and other types of family support.

## Summer Holiday Childcare

If you still need to find childcare for all or part of the Summer holidays then it might not be too late!

Sutton Family Information Service can provide you with a personalised list of the Ofsted registered Holiday Clubs and Childminders offering childcare in your area.



Depending on your circumstances, there may also be financial help available to meet the costs of using registered childcare.

Using a registered childcare provider means that your child/ren can meet new friends and have fun taking part in stimulating, planned activities. Holiday clubs and childminders organise trips to local places as well as having a wide range of planned activities suitable for all ages. Many can offer you the flexibility to pick and choose the hours you need.

If your child will be starting school in September and you need childcare before and/or after school, we can help with this too. Just contact us with the name of your child's school and we will send you a list of the Ofsted registered childcare providers who offer before and after school childcare for children attending that particular school.

## Early Years Pupil Premium - Is your child aged 3-4?

Your childcare provider may be entitled to funding to support their learning

From April 2015, nurseries, schools, childminders and other childcare providers are able to claim additional government funding of up to £300 a year through the Early Years Pupil Premium. The funding is to support the development, learning and care of your three or four year old child based on eligible criteria.

The funding is used by the childcare provider as they think best to support your child in the following areas:

- Personal, social and emotional development
- Communication and language
- Physical development
- Literacy
- Mathematics
- Understanding the world
- Expressive arts and design

On receiving the funding early years providers can choose how they wish to spend it but will need to demonstrate to Ofsted how the funding is being used effectively.

The funding is available for any hours up to a maximum of 15 hours per week in accordance with the free entitlement to early education for all three and four year olds.






