#### Meeting 4 – daytime

Friday 18th October 2019 – for Post-16 learners (current Year 11)

This will be held at the Sutton Central Library, St Nicholas Way, Sutton, SM1 1EA at 10.30 am – 12 noon.

#### WHAT WILL HAPPEN AT THE MEETINGS?

There will be a short presentation about the post-16/19 transition process for securing a place in education, training or employment. The presentation will outline what you need to do to plan for identifying appropriate education/training/employment pathways that build on education experiences so far.





This is important to ensure progress in achieving desired outcomes and aspirations. The presentation will be followed by an opportunity for you to ask any questions you have about the process.

Education/training providers have also been invited to attend to explain what they can provide and to answer questions.

We have invited <u>all</u> parents/carers of young people (and young people themselves who are 16 years of age and over) currently in Years 11, 13 and 14 who have an EHC plan maintained by the London Borough of Sutton. This is because the process centres on the EHC plan review meeting which will involve all who have an EHC plan.
