# Proposed parking changes for Park Hill (outside 72-76)

We're writing to you as part of our ongoing review of parking in Sutton.

Parking remains one of the issues of most concern to residents in Sutton and we have received many requests for a review of parking arrangements across the borough.

### Proposals for Park Hill (outside 72-76)

We propose to add double yellow lines outside 72-76 Park Hill due to insufficient space for a car to park without blocking crossovers (see Map on the back of this letter).


This informal stage of consultation will end on **September 21 2022**. We will review the feedback and speak with ward councillors before a decision is made whether to progress any formal proposals for changes.
