Proposed parking changes for Belmont

I'm writing to you as part of our ongoing review of parking in Sutton. Parking remains one of the issues of most concern to residents in Sutton and we have received many requests for a review of parking arrangements across the borough.

Proposals for Chiltern Road, Heath Drive and The Highway

We are proposing some changes in these roads due parking pressures from the hospital and nearby school (see detailed maps on the back of this letter). The proposals include:

- Changing the operating hours of single yellow lines in Chiltern Road, Heath Drive and The Highway.
- New double yellow lines on a short section of Heath Drive and Chiltern Road.
- New single yellow lines on a short section of Chiltern Road.
- Extending the zebra crossing zig zags and introducing bus stop markings on Chiltern Road outside the school.

We are not proposing any changes to Bassett Close.

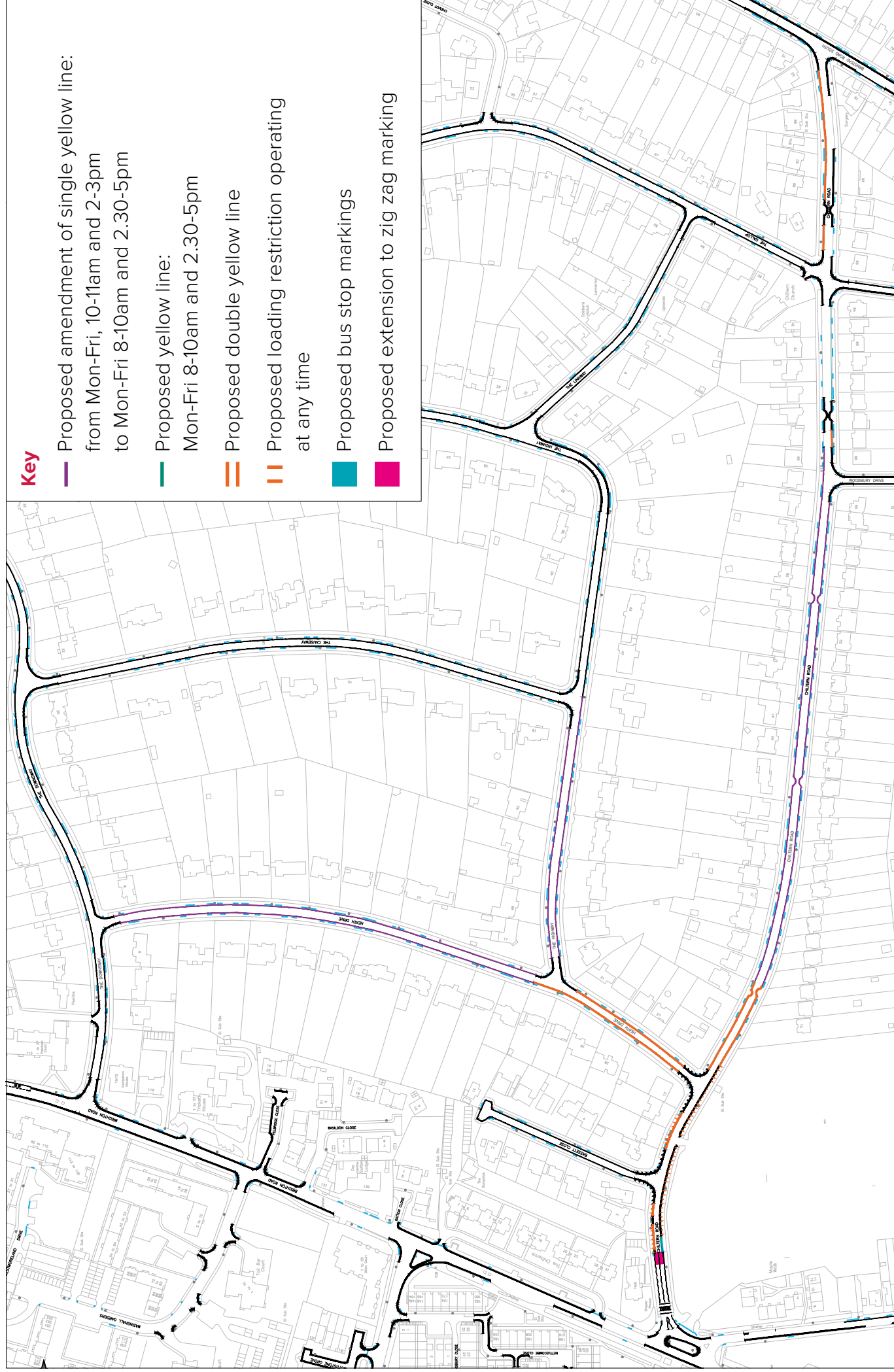
This informal stage of consultation will end on **15 June 2023**. We will review the feedback and speak with ward councillors before a decision is made whether to progress any formal proposals for changes.

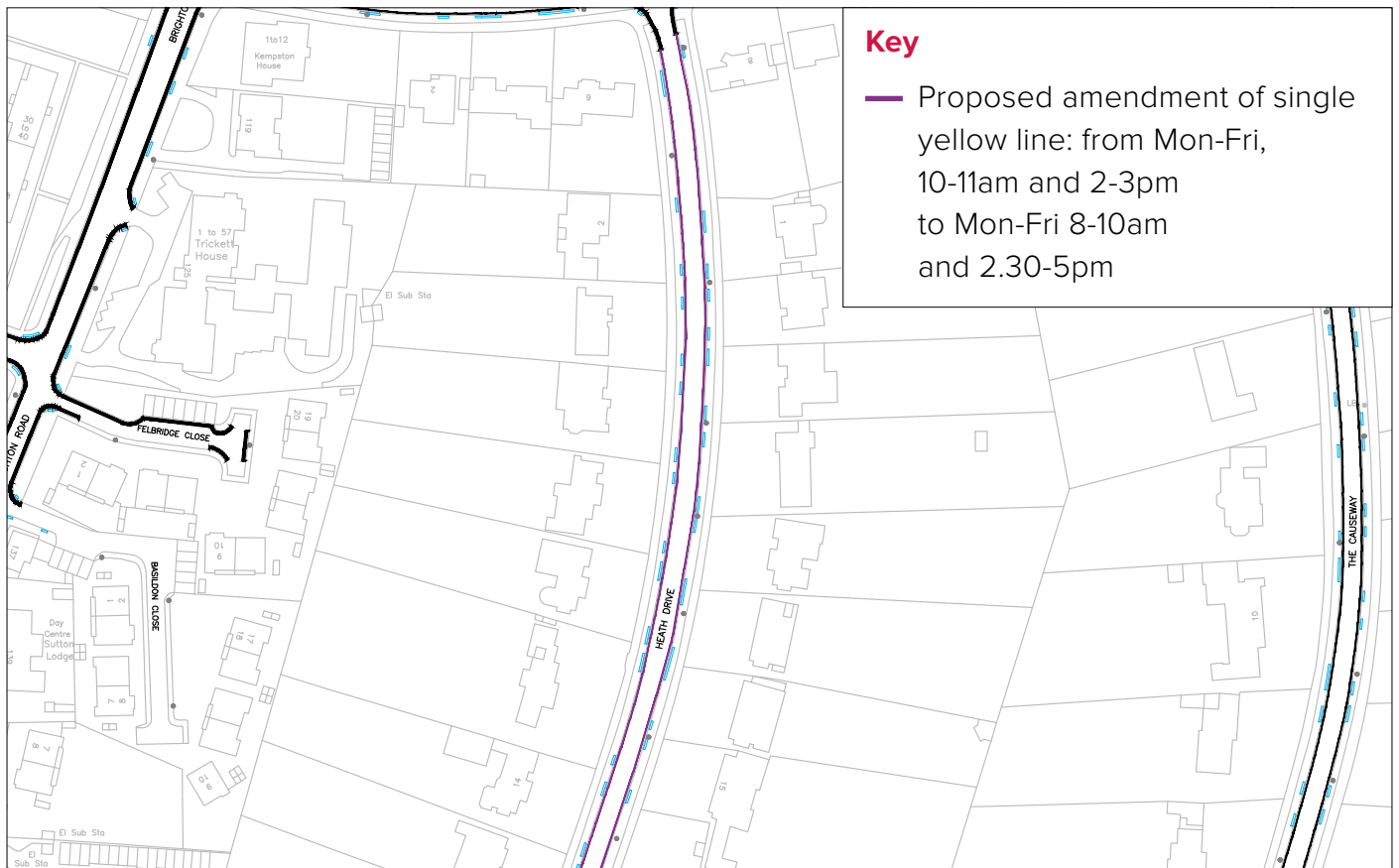

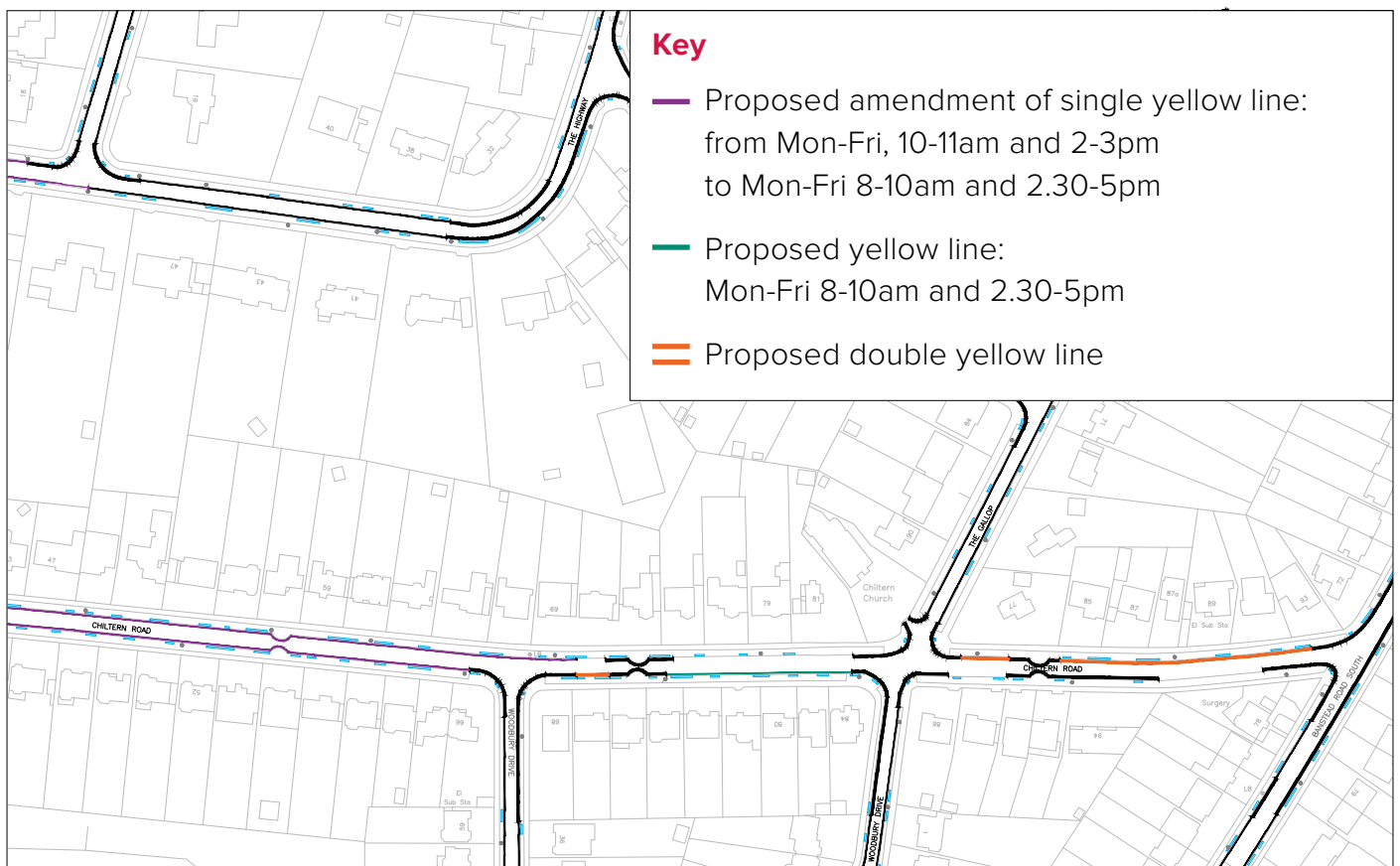
