## Proposed parking changes for Wealdstone Road

We're writing to you as part of our ongoing review of parking in Sutton.

Parking remains one of the issues of most concern to residents in Sutton and we have received many requests for a review of parking arrangements across the borough.

### Proposals for Wealdstone Road

Following feedback about parking facilities on Wealdstone Road, we are proposing to introduce single line waiting restrictions operating seven days a week from midnight to 7.30am (**see Map on the back of this letter**).
