All emergency exits will be always kept clear of obstruction.

All customers will be asked to leave the premises quietly.  
Clear & legible notices will be prominently displayed to remind customers to leave quietly and have regard for our neighbours.

**e) The protection of children from harm**

The licensee and the staff will ask persons who appear to be underage of 25 for photographic ID such as proof of age cards, The connexions Card and Citizen card, photographic driving license or passport or an official identity card with photo ID and date of birth.

All staff will be trained for underage sales prevention, regularly.

Our premises is a food outlet, therefore most alcohol will be served with food.



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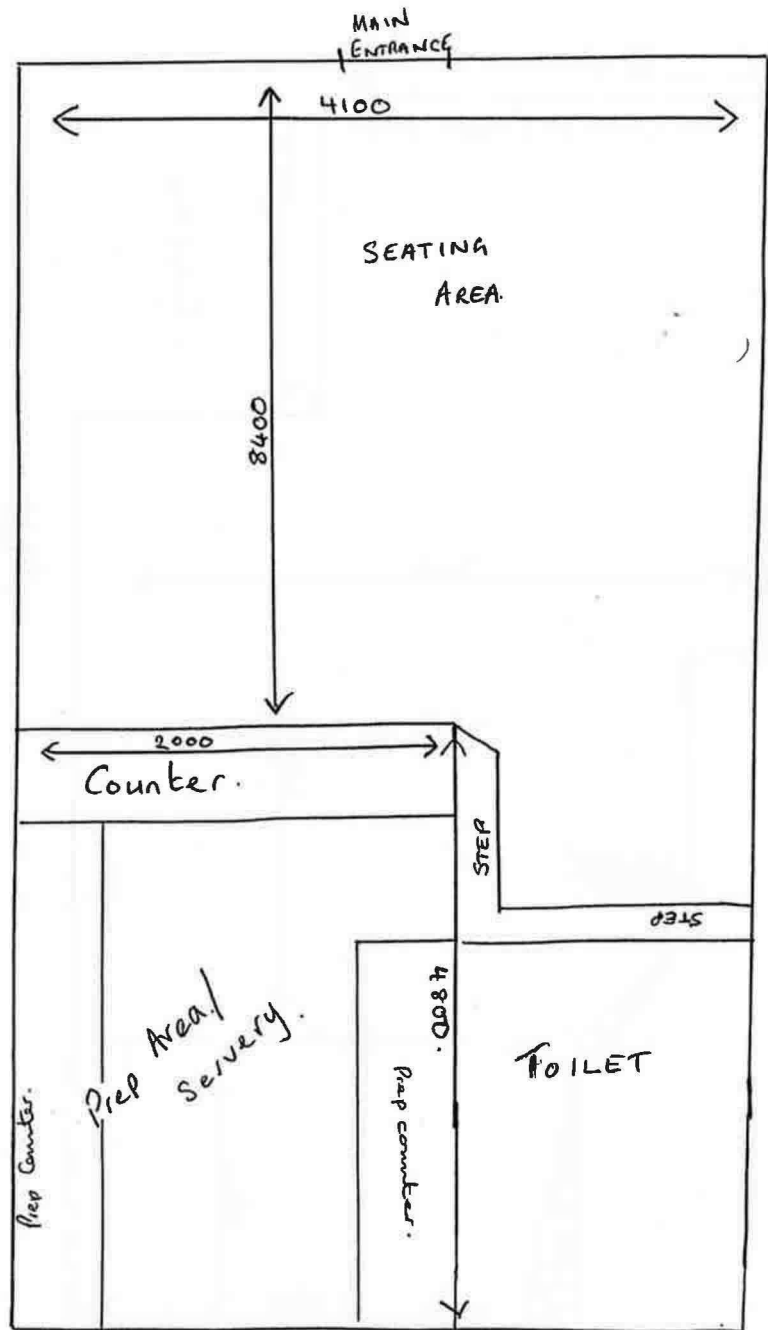

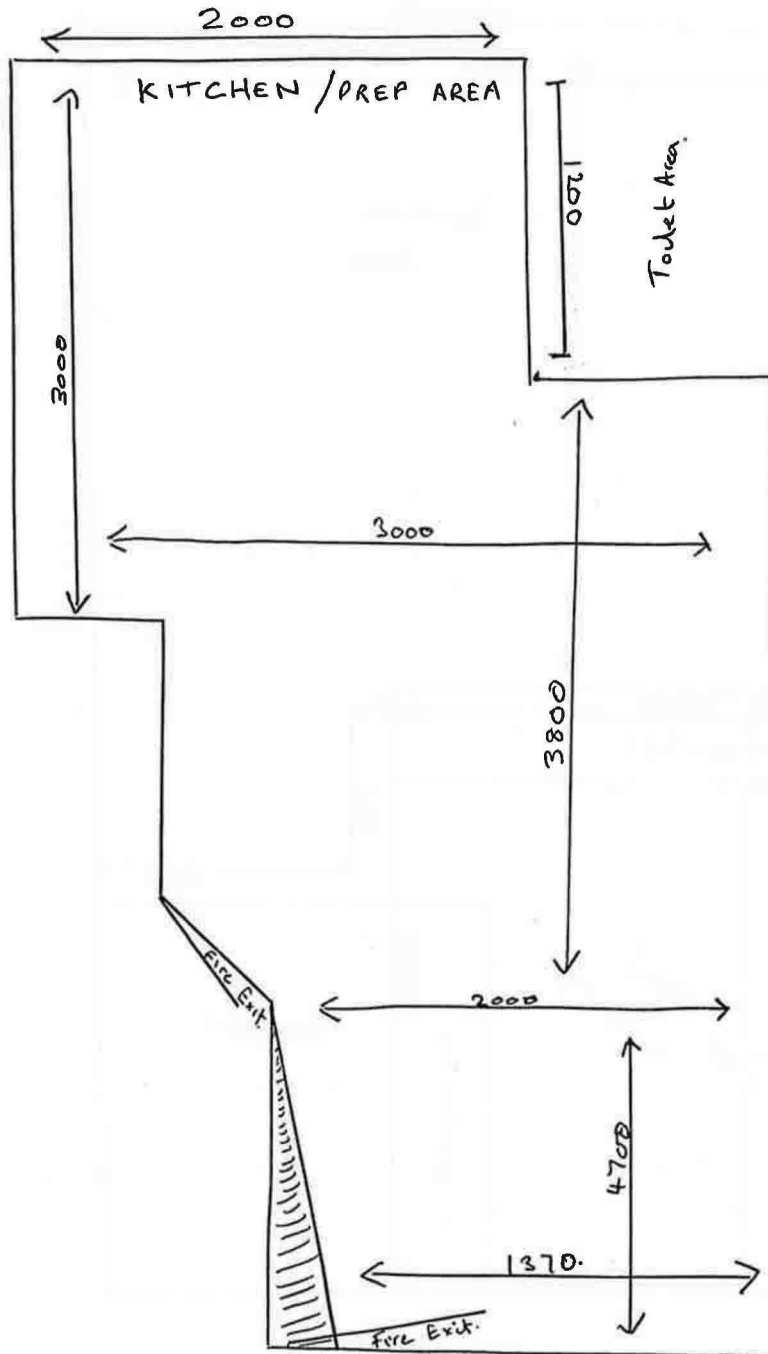
