While parents unwind, children have the chance to engage in play under the supervision of a play worker. This allows children to socialise, learn, and explore in a safe and structured environment.














The nearest bus stops within 1–2 minutes' walking distance (about 100 m):

- High Street / Marshalls Road (Stop X): served by routes 80, 151, 164, 213, 280, 413, 470, 613, N44, S1, S3
- Crown Road (Stop D or C): same set plus 154:
  80,151,154,164,213,280,470,613,N44,S1,S3
- Clarence Road is a residential street—a permit or on-street parking may be required. There is limited parking onsite.
- Sutton town centre restricts vehicle access in the pedestrianised High Street, so make sure to follow signed access signs when turning into Clarence Road.
