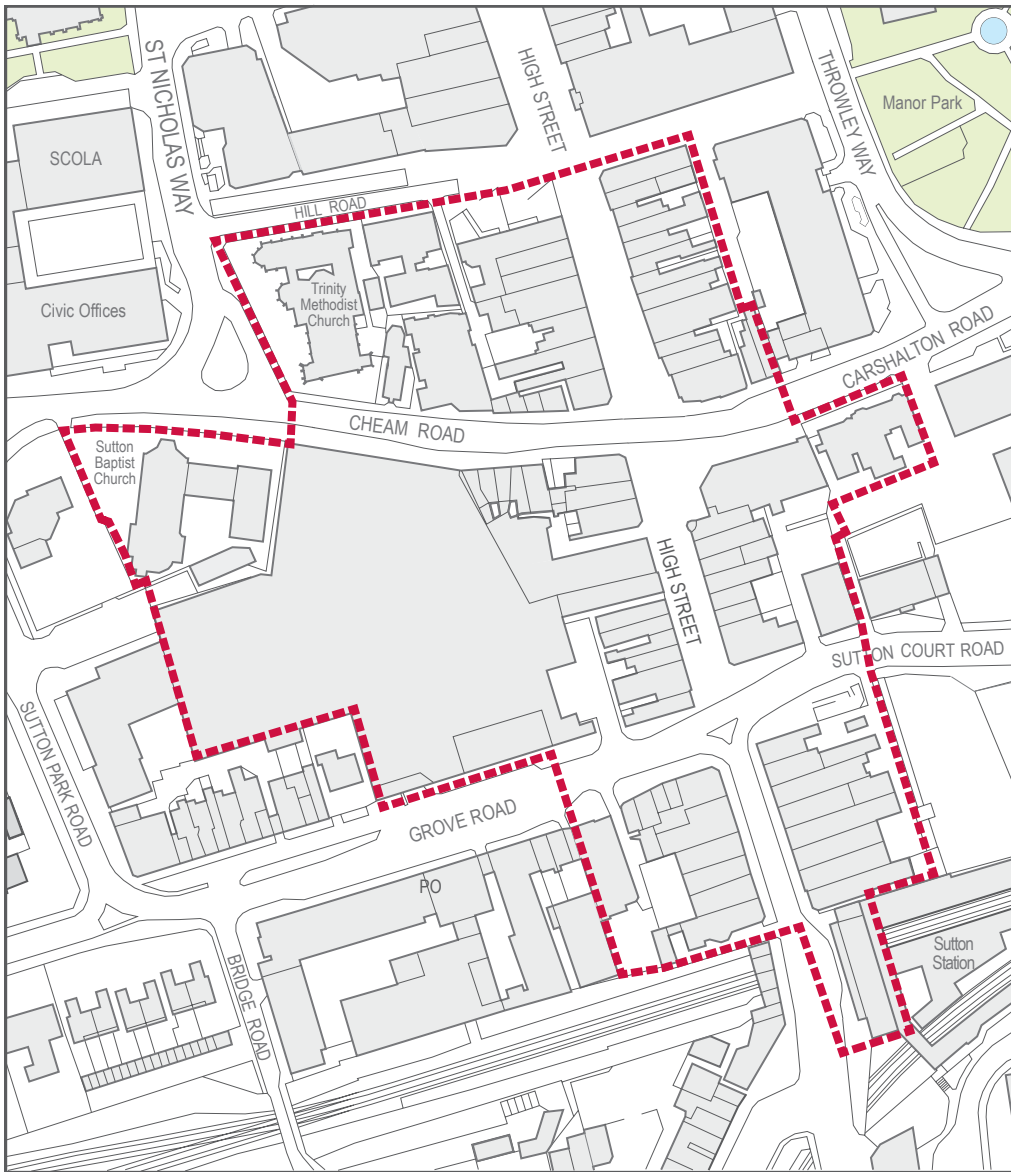
NOTICE OF DESIGNATION OF CONSERVATION AREA AT SUTTON TOWN CENTRE HIGH STREET CROSSROADS

The London Borough of Sutton hereby gives notice of its designation of a new conservation area, to be known as Sutton Town Centre High Street Crossroads Conservation Area, on 9 May 2011.

Sutton Station; *High Street*: 1-67 (odd), 2-76 (even); *Grove Road*: 1-9 (odd), 14-30 (even); *Sutton Court Road*: Bank House; *Carshalton Road*: 1-9 (odd), 2 and Sutton Police Station; *Cheam Road*: 1-9 (odd), Sutton Baptist Church, 2-14 (even), Trinity Methodist Church; *Hill Road*: 5-9 (Georgian Mansions).
