

Sutton Parents Forum Café September 2017 Restructure of Sutton Education Services (SES)

Adrian Williams, Interim Head of Education, will be joining us to discuss the restructure of Sutton Education Services (SES), the implications of the new arrangements for parent/carers of children and young people with additional needs and to answer any questions.

Our understanding is that the proposed restructure includes deleting the post of Manager of Parent Partnership Services (SIAS) which is a vital impartial advice service for families, reducing the ASD service and deleting an Educational Psychologist (EP) post.

Having written to Councillor Hookway, Councillor James, Councillor Pascoe and senior officers from the Local Authority, the Steering Group met with Adrian Williams, Kieran Holliday, the Head of Pupil Based Commissioning and Councillor Jane Pascoe to raise concerns about the proposed further cuts to services, to highlight the value of these services to our families and to ask that the Local Authority provide more funding for SES to ensure that they can continue to support our families.

We consider that these services are already at breaking point due to continual cuts and this is already impacting negatively on families with disabled children and young people. We are making representations at all levels on behalf of parent/carers and will continue to do so.

We hope that this meeting will be well attended to ensure that our collective voice is heard.
