Applications to vote by proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm Wednesday 17 October 2018**. (Emergency applications to vote by proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm, Thursday 25 October 2018)

Postal ballot papers will be sent 1st class on **Friday 5th October 2018**.
