



Hackbridge and Beddington Corner Neighbourhood Plan Information Statement

A referendum relating to the Hackbridge and Beddington Corner Neighbourhood Plan will be held on **29 November 2018**.

The question that will be asked in the Referendum is **'Do you want the London Borough of Sutton to use the neighbourhood plan for Hackbridge and Beddington Corner to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?'**

The referendum area is identified on the map in Annex 1. The Referendum area is identical to the area that has been designated as the Hackbridge and Beddington Corner Neighbourhood Plan Area.

A person is entitled to vote in the Referendum if:

- They is entitled to vote in an election of any Councillor of Sutton Council whose area is in the Referendum area; and
- Their qualifying address for the election is in the Referendum area. A person's qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the register of electors, the address in respect of which he or she is entitled to be registered.

The referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the Referendum is £740 +6p per entry in the Referendum Register of Electors.

The number of persons entitled to vote in the Referendum by reference to which that limit has been calculated is 4124.

The referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures that are similar to those used at local government elections.
